Year 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Our Mission and School Ethos.</b> How to Identify Wickersley Values. How do we recognise Wickersley Values; School Council. How do we better equip students to develop Wickersley Attributes.</li> <li>• <b>Enrichment</b> Give it a go, take responsibility for your own path. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a range of different activities from D of E to Cooking on a budget as well as Teaching, Sports, Learning Spanish as a beginner as well as Media. We will be encouraging all year 12 students to take up at least 1 enrichment activity if not 2. <b>Block 1 &amp; 2 (10 Weeks)</b></li> <li>• <b>Form Activities</b> Extra Mile (Curiosity) – Students will take part in a range of citizenship activities including sponsored walk and activities to raise money for charity.</li> <li>• <b>Google Calendar</b> Organised and Professionalism – students will complete planning tasks to prepare for deadlines considering skills and techniques.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>One to One Meetings</b> Don't give up and give it a go. Using data collection, students will have the chance to discuss areas of development, in particular in preparation for mock exams and how to stay mentally and physically healthy.</li> <li>• This will include R – taking responsibility for revision timetabling and organising time.</li> <li>• <b>Enrichment</b> Block 3 &amp; 4 students will have the opportunity to further develop their ambition and take further control of their future by completing more enrichment activities either similar or different.</li> <li>• Enrichment will further enhance high expectations and values.</li> <li>• <b>Form Activities</b> Extra Mile – Citizenship and Physical Health Week – Where students will have the opportunity to consider how to change their lifestyles for the better as well as improve community environments.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>One to One Meetings</b> Will again consider final data collections in preparation for UCAS. This will include personal statement writing and UCAS application. Students will be encouraged to take responsibility for their actions and path in order to ascertain the best grades possible to get on the university course of their choice.</li> <li>• <b>Enrichment</b> Block 5 &amp; 6 – As in term 1 and 2, students will now have an even better idea about the enrichment requirements. Year 13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Ready 2 Learn focus</b> We will look at what ready to learn means for Y13 focussing on professionalism and taking responsibility for progress.</li> <li>• <b>Drive and Ambition</b> In the first term we will be supporting students to make good choices for their future.</li> <li>• <b>Citizenship</b> In term 1 we will focus on voting rights, radicalisation and race relations in the UK.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Ready 2 Learn</b> Give it a go and don't give up. We will be preparing for mock exams thinking about how to stay mentally and physically healthy while revising and how to deal with results good or bad.</li> <li>• <b>Drive and Ambition</b> Wickersley has high expectations and our students should be aiming high when they leave looking for the best opportunity not the easiest path.</li> <li>• <b>Citizenship</b> In this term we will be thinking about the changing world students live in focussing on issues of climate change and the impact of technology on this generation.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Ready 2 Learn</b> Taking Responsibility. By this stage teachers have done what they need to do.
