The form tutor sees your child each morning and can check in with them to resolve any issues or to pass them on to a relevant person.

We operate pastoral hubs in school which means that we have a dedicated team of staff who can deal with issues and support your child if necessary. Each hub consists of a Head of Key Stage, Non-Teaching Assistant Heads of Year, Teaching Assistants, Learning Mentors and Family Support Workers. This means we can offer timely support and guidance to our students whenever they need it.
