#### Dear Parents/carers

As we approach the new academic year I would like to take this opportunity to outline and clarify the Wickersley School and Sports College PE Kit.

The PE kit is an extension of our School Uniform Policy. We aim for students to look uniform and smart, while of course ensuring health and safety.

# School PE kit includes:

#### T-shirt

WSSC black and green branded PE T-Shirt (compulsory)

No other t-shirt is permitted including plain black t-shirts, movement festival t-shirt or the old style WSSC PE t-shirt.

## Leggings/Tracksuit Bottoms

Any plain black or with a small logo. They do not have to be school branded, although these are available to purchase if you wish.

If pupils choose to wear leggings, please ensure they are sports leggings and not fashion leggings which can sometimes be transparent.

#### **Shorts**

Any plain black or with a small logo. They do not have to be school branded, although these are available to purchase if you wish.

Please ensure any shorts are mid thigh length. Short and excessively tight shorts are not permitted.

# Jumper/Hoodie/Zip up Top

Any plain black or with a small logo. They do not have to be school branded, although these are available to purchase if you wish.



# **Waterproof Top**

- Optional extra in wet weather but please ensure these are black, thin and appropriate for sports participation.

No outdoor coats can be worn as an alternative.

## Underlayers/Gloves/Snoods

In cold weather pupils are able to wear thin underlayers, gloves or snoods. These just need to be black.

## **Trainers/Footwear**

- Any colour sports style trainers

Pupils cannot wear their school shoes as PE trainers, they must bring a separate pair of sports appropriate trainers. Fashion trainers, Converse, Vans, Crocs or sliders are not permitted.

## Long hair

- Long hair must be tied back in a bobble

#### Jewellery

- All jewellery MUST be removed before the lesson.

New piercings are recommended during the 6 week school holidays to give adequate healing time and enable removal. If a piercing cannot be removed, pupils must bring their own medical tape to cover.

## False nails

- In line with the School Uniform Policy false nails or nail enhancements of any kind are not permitted.

Please keep own natural nails short. In PE this is for health and safety purposes of both the direct pupil and others they may be playing against/with.

## If a pupil forgets or brings incorrect kit in line with the above Policy:

- Pupils will be supplied with kit to borrow
- Any refusal to borrow kit will result in a sanctions referral
